




We end the year looking at another biblical prayer. Paul expresses great appreciation as he looks back; at the same time, he has a powerful request for more. We will join him in that prayer.

Niagara Christian Gleaners – In 2023 we were entrusted with over 3 million lbs of fresh, surplus produce. With these generous food donations and with the help of our volunteers and financial supporters we were able to prepare and share over 13 million servings of dehydrated food aid in

2023. Through our trusted distribution partners, we sent food into 9 different countries including Canada. Out of the more than 13 million servings, over 4 million servings were used as crisis aid in Poland, Romania and Ukraine as the war in that region continues. The global demand for food aid continues to grow as food insecurity is the reality for many across the world. Canada is incredibly blessed with an abundance of food and our willingness to compassionately share with others is the test we want to pass - all in Christ's name. 
