

Join us Sunday morning at 10 am or anytime throughout the week. This Sunday Pastor Erick will present the second of a 4-part series on Power, looking at "The Power of Weakness." He will be looking at 2 Corinthians chapter 12 verses 1-10.



Foundational to understanding power is recognizing the confusing biblical idea that power comes through weakness. Jesus exemplified this on the cross and Paul experienced it in ministry. How do we take this difficult teaching and apply it to our lives today?

On Sunday January 21 we will be holding a **CONGREGATIONAL VOTE** on whether we will extend an official call to Pastor Jolene as Minister of the Word and Pastoral Care Pastor. You may remember that we voted to bring her on staff with the assumption of this later vote. That was like a "promise ring"; January 21 is the engagement vote. Her classis exam is scheduled for February 28 and the ordination is being planned for Sunday March 3 (that is like the marriage ceremony).
