


Join us Sunday morning at 10 am or anytime throughout the week. This Sunday Pastor Erick will present the first of a 4-part series on Power, beginning with "The Power of Words." He will be looking at a number of passages Luke 4:31-37; 1 Corinthians 2:1-5; 1 Thessalonians 1:4-6; Ephesians 4:14-15.



Words have power. Jesus spoke with authority. Paul taught with conviction. We are called to speak the truth in love. We will explore how these things are connected as we begin the new year together.

On Sunday January 21 we will be holding a congregation vote on whether we will extend an official call to Pastor Jolene. You may remember that we voted to bring her on staff with the assumption of this later vote. That was like a "promise ring"; January 21 is the engagement vote; her classis exam is scheduled for February 28; and the ordination is being planned for Sunday March 3 (that is like the marriage ceremony).
